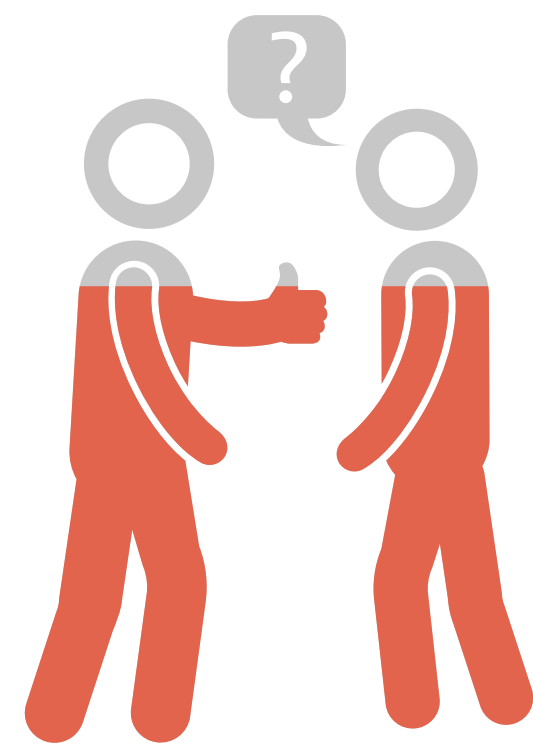


NHS Staff Survey 2022

The NHS Staff Survey is the largest collection of feedback from people working in the NHS. It gathers views on staff experience at work, and almost 636,348 staff from 264 NHS organisations* took part in the 2022 survey.

In 2021 the survey was redeveloped to include new questions and scores aligned with the seven elements of the NHS People Promise and the 2022 NHS Staff Survey provides the first trend data on these new measures.

of staff said that if a friend or relative needed treatment they would be happy with the standard of care provided by their organisation

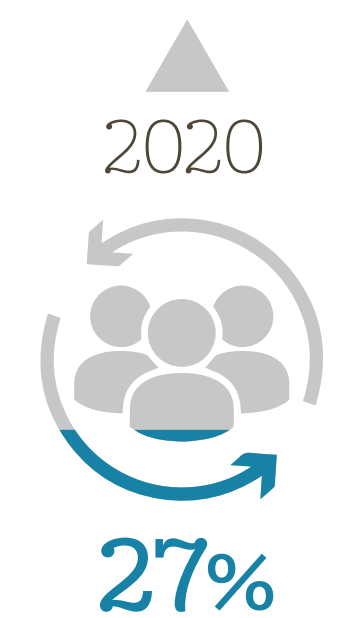


STAFF RETENTION

of staff were satisfied with their level of pay

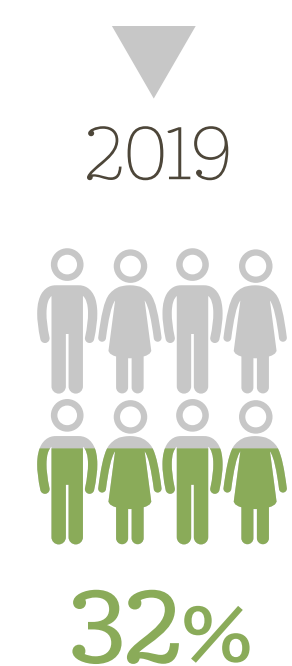


STAFFING LEVELS

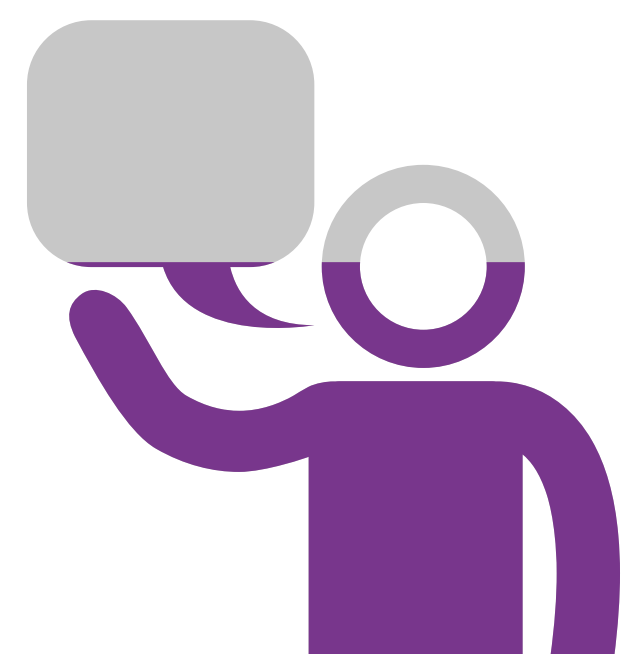
