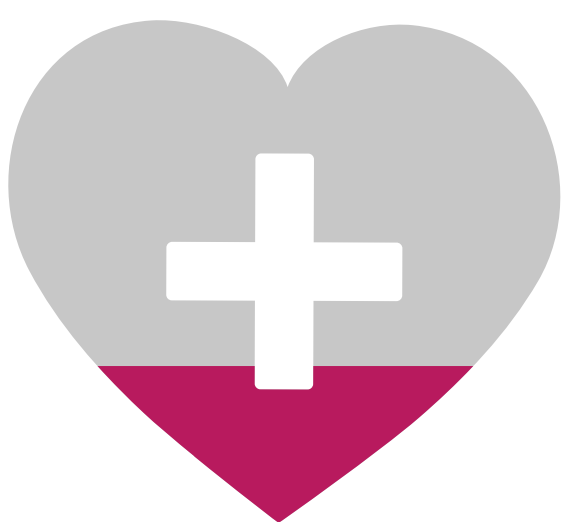


NHS Staff Survey 2018

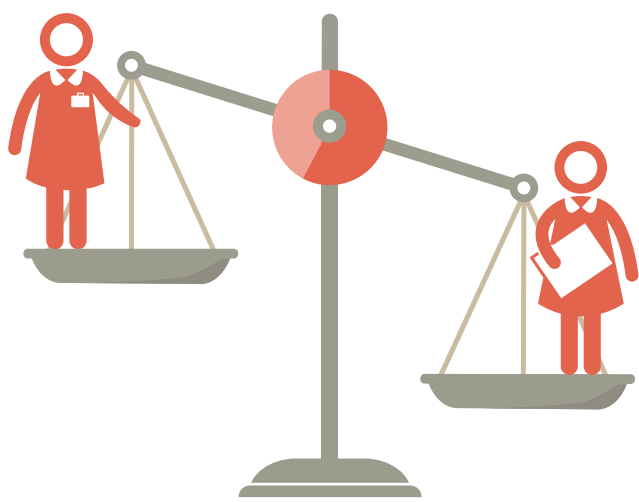

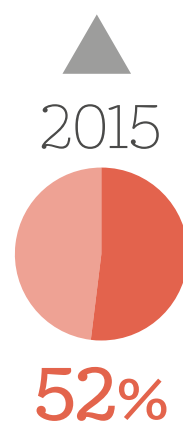

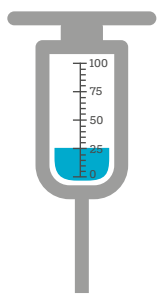

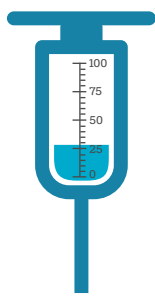

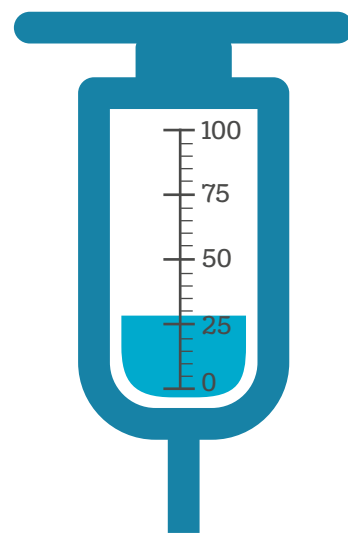
