

Inpatients Survey 2018

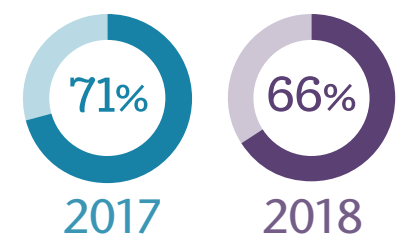
76,668 patients responded to the survey

Results from this year's survey show concerning declines around information, coordination of care, patient feedback and support. However, patient privacy remains high.



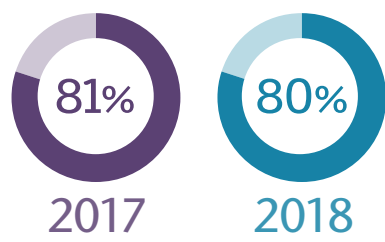
66%

of patients 'completely' received clear written or printed information about their medications



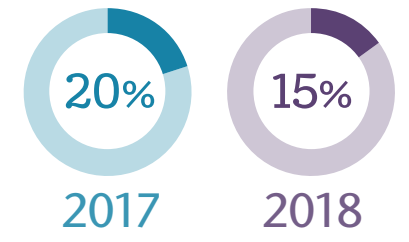
80%

of patients said hospital staff discussed with them whether they needed any further health or social care services after leaving hospital



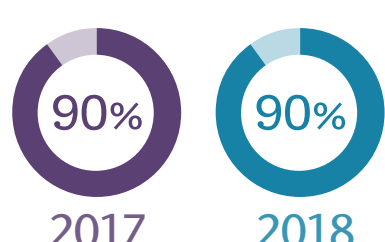
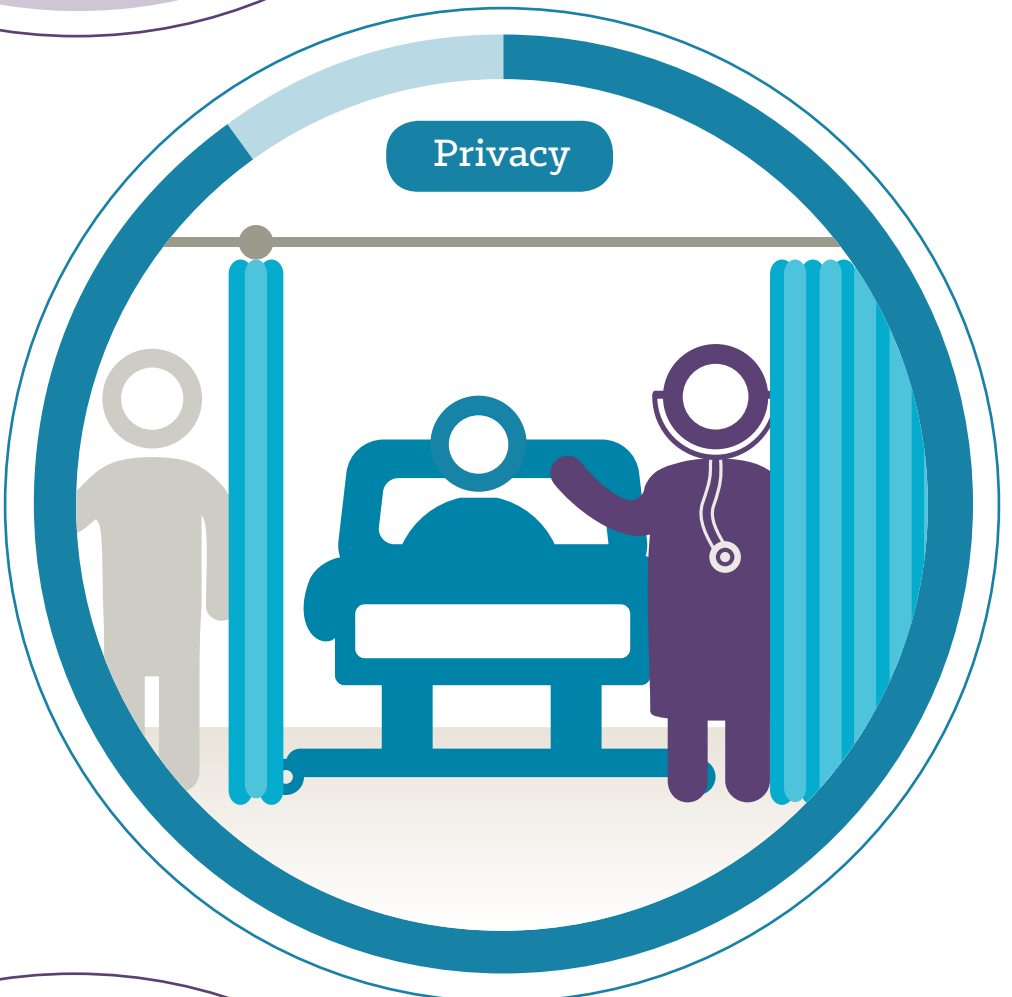
15%
